- **A7**
- **Em** (E minor - optional for flavor)

me.

Verse 5 He [G] speaks, and listening [C] to His [G] voice, New [G] life the [Em] dead
re[D]ceive; The [G] mournful, broken [C] hearts re[G]joice, The [C] humble [G] poor [D7]
be[G]lieve.
